When strolling through Regensburg you encounter evidence of the city's magnificent history every step of the way. The city is rich in historical monuments. Here are some of the attractions no visitor to Regensburg should miss.



Steinerne Brücke (Stone Bridge)

The Stone Bridge was built between 1135 and 1146. For centuries it was the only permanent crossing on the Danube between Ulm and Vienna. The "Bruckmandl" (man on the bridge) in the middle of the bridge has been gazing towards the city since the 15th century. Legend has it that this figure is the master builder of the bridge who made a bet with the master builder of the cathedral that he would be the first to finish his work. In reality, though, the figure is more likely a symbol of Regensburg's rights as a free city. As the water passes through the narrow channels beneath the bridge, strong currents are created that used to be very dangerous for ships. Today, however, a boat ride through the whirlpools is a must for every visitor to Regensburg.



Dom St. Peter (St. Peter's Cathedral)

Regensburg's St. Peter's Cathedral is the only Gothic cathedral in Bavaria. Construction of the monumental building took almost 600 years, with the two 105m-tall spires not being completed until the 19th century. Unveiled after years of restoration, the main portal on the west face of the building welcomes the visitor with its rich adornment of figures. On the inside, all eyes are drawn to the colourful medieval stained-glass windows. The cathedral is the episcopal church of the diocese of Regensburg. Sunday Mass is accompanied by the wonderful sounds of the world-famous Regensburger Domspatzen boy's choir.

Altes Rathaus (Old Town Hall)

In 1245, Emperor Frederick II bestowed the privileged status of Imperial Free City on Regensburg. The foundations for the Old Town Hall were laid the year before.

Not only did the town council meet here, but rulers and delegates from all over Europe also gathered in this building. Around the 16th century, the so-called Imperial Diets were held more and more frequently and took longer and longer – until the assembly was finally established permanently in Regensburg. The Perpetual Diet held meetings in the city between 1663 and 1806 – in some ways a precursor of today's UN General Assembly.

Schloss Thurn und Taxis mit Basilika St. Emmeram

(Thurn and Taxis Palace and the St. Emmeram Basilica)

The aristocratic line of Thurn and Taxis has had its ancestral home in the former Benedictine monastery of St. Emmeram since 1812. The buildings of the famous monastery go back to the 8th century. The princes had the south wing of the monastery torn down towards the end of the 19th century and replaced by a palace in the New Renaissance style. The entire complex has more rooms than Buckingham Palace and today is the largest palace in Germany which is still a family home.



Porta Praetoria

The Porta Praetoria is considered one of the grandest surviving Roman constructions in Germany. It was built around 179 A.D. under Emperor Marcus Aurelius and used as a gateway until late into the Middle Ages. Not until the middle of the 17th century did it disappear from view due to building encroachment. The gateway was uncovered again between 1885 and 1887. During excavations in 1971, archaeologists discovered that it originally had been part of a larger complex.

Medieval Town Centre

In Regensburg, historic buildings are combined in a unique way with modern retail outlets and all types of restaurants.

In 2006, UNESCO granted the Old Town World Heritage status because of its many historic buildings. Like almost no other city, Regensburg has managed to combine these historic buildings with retail business. 400 of the 600 stores in the Old Town are located in historic buildings or vaulted cellars. A host of small shops operate next to the big department stores.

In the south of the city centre, the **Regensburg Arcaden** promise lots of shopping fun in any kind of weather. A covered walkway connects them directly to the main station.

There are many ways to get to Regensburg. Whether you are traveling by car or by train, here are some of the best routes and train connections.

Hohenfels

Distance: approx. 25 miles (40 km).

Did the Ancient Romans Brew Beer?

A Great Beer tradition

Historians are divided on the question. What is beyond doubt is that good beer has a long tradition in Regensburg. And that in this city it is possible to drink for a good cause.

The year 179 AD is generally accepted as the date of the foundation of Regensburg, when the Emperor Marcus Aurelius erected the Roman fortress of Castra Regina. Around the legionnaires' encampment, farmsteads emerged to provide the soldiers and civilian population with provi-

ons. Within the modern city limits, archaeologists have discovered the remains of a Roman agricultural building which at first some took to be a brewery. But whether it began with the Romans, or with later inhabitants of the city, beer has been brewed in Regensburg for a very long time. Three breweries are still operating today.

Dicker Mann Restaurant

This quaint restaurant-pub in the heart of the Old Town is known for its historical ambience. From the outside you are drawn in by its impressive architecture - the tower-like gabled roof resting on Tuscan half-pillars, and once inside, you are captivated by its unique atmosphere. In summer, the Mediterranean flair can be felt while sitting in the courtyard or the idyllic Krebsgasse.

Bischofshof

a success story from the Oberpfalz

The Bischofshof brewery is inseparably linked to the complex of buildings that gave it its name. The historical bishop court with the Bischofshof restaurant is directly located next to the cathedral, still today a jewel of Regensburg's gastronomy and hospitality. The first beginnings of the brewery are attested in the year 1649, when the dry throats of the artisans who built Regensburg cathedral required fresh beer. Today the brewery's profits go to the training of priests in the diocese of Regensburg.

The world's oldest monastery brewery opens its doors

Discover the origin of the award-winning Weltenburg dark beer and find out what is so special about the „Maerzen“ beer.

Peek into the brewhouse for a close look at a working brewery and learn in the visitors' center about the monastery's 1000 years of history. Find your favorite beer during a beer tasting, where you may keep your own original Weltenburg beer glass. The oldest monastic brewery in the world opens its doors to you. See inside the brewhouse, and in the visitors' centre, hear about the millennium-old beer tradition. Enjoy a beer-tasting and take home an original Weltenburg glass as a souvenir.

The beer house was almost always open: for a snack in the morning, for lunch and for a “Halbe” (a half-litre of beer) after a day’s work. Here the people discussed politics, shared news, gossiped and argued. Sometimes with their fists: it all depended who walked in. Actually, there was always someone there, be it the farmer, the builder, the teacher, the pharmacist or the priest. Everyone knew everyone, and they would no sooner run out of things to talk about than the landlord would run out of fresh beer!

IMPRINT

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World Heritage Site

Regensburg is sensational: what locals and visitors to the city on the River Danube have always known was officially confirmed in the summer of 2006 by the decision to have the historic town centre join the ranks of UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

As you stroll through Regensburg's Old Town, you feel you have been whisked back to a time long gone. Here the medieval structure of the city, with its narrow alleys, Patrician houses, churches and monasteries, residential and public buildings, has been preserved to this day like in no other German city. The overall "ensemble of Regensburg's town centre and Stadthof" formed the basis for the World Heritage Site Application.
